RESEARCH AWARDS

Creating a local culture that encourages and supports the conduct of nurse-led studies and the application of evidence-based nursing practice is a strategic goal of The Connecticut Nursing Research Alliance. In support of this goal, the Alliance has established two awards to recognize excellence in the conduct of research and evidence-based practice.

Excellence in Nursing Research Award: The purpose of this award is to recognize nursing researchers for their contribution to the advancement of nursing science and professional practice through the conduct of research. The award is presented each Fall during the Annual CT Nursing Research Alliance Conference to a deserving nurse whose completed research is considered exemplary and who serves as a role model for his/her nursing colleagues.

Excellence in Evidence-Based Practice Award: The purpose of this award is to recognize an individual or group who has used research findings as a basis for practice innovation or has provided leadership for evidence-based practice changes in the clinical setting. The award is presented each Fall during the Annual CT Nursing Research Alliance Conference.

Awards are open to CT Nursing Alliance Member Organizations, which include: Bristol Hospital, Capitol Community College, Central Connecticut State University, Charlotte Hungerford Hospital, Eastern Connecticut Health Network, Hartford Hospital, Hospital of Central Connecticut, Hospital of Saint Raphael, Hospital for Special Care, Midstate Medical Center, Quinnipiac University, Saint Joseph College, Southern Connecticut State University, University of Connecticut, University of Hartford, William Backus Hospital and Windham Hospital.

Hartford Healthcare Corporation (HHCC) provides an additional Evidence-Based Practice Project Grant, open to HHCC member organizations, which include: Hartford Hospital, Midstate Medical Center, Jefferson House, VNA Health Care, and Windham Hospital.

Evidence-Based Practice Project Grant: In support of Hartford Healthcare Corporation's organizational goal to support evidence-based practice, dedicated funds are available to facilitate the initiation of evidence-based practice projects. Monies (in the amount up to \$1500.00) can be made available throughout the year.

EXCELLENCE IN NURSING RESEARCH AWARD

THE AWARD

The Excellence in Nursing Research Award is presented annually to a deserving nurse whose completed research is considered exemplary and who serves as a role model for his/her Nursing colleagues. Award includes a monetary grant of \$500 to be used to help defray expenses in presenting research findings at a forthcoming research conference.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Applicant must be an employee or enrolled student of a CT Nursing Research Alliance member organization.
2. Research must be current; completed within the last year.
3. Research must demonstrate relevance to nursing management, education, or practice.
4. Principal investigator must be a nurse.
5. Researcher must show evidence that research was externally validated as a legitimate study; i.e. approval by the Nursing Research Committee.

SUBMISSION PROCESS

1. Complete Nomination Form.
2. Submit abstract of research including purpose/rationale for the study, pertinent review of literature, description of research design, methodology, data analysis, study findings and implications for practice.
3. Nomination Form and completed abstract must be received by deadline date of **9/20/10.**

EXCELLENCE IN EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICE AWARD

THE AWARD

The Excellence in Evidence-Based Practice Award is presented annually to an individual or group who has either used research as a basis for a practice innovation or has provided leadership for evidence-based practice changes in the clinical setting. The award includes a monetary grant of \$500 to be used to help defray expenses in attending an Evidence-Based Practice conference at the regional or national level.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. The nominee is an employee or enrolled student of a CT Nursing Research Alliance member organization.
2. The individual or group has either directly influenced an evidence-based innovation in Nursing Practice or provided supportive leadership for the project/innovation.
3. There is evidence of an impact on:
 - a) improved patient outcomes.
 - b) improved quality and patient safety.
 - c) improved patient/family satisfaction.
 - d) cost-savings to patient(s).
 - e) cost-savings to hospital/institution.
 - f) improved staff motivation and knowledge.
 - g) improved staff satisfaction due to change in patient care delivery process.

SUBMISSION PROCESS

1. Complete Nomination Form.
2. Candidate (contact person if group nomination) must submit Abstract of the project/innovation including:
 - a) identification of the problem
 - b) evidence of research foundation including listing of major literary citations used
 - c) description of specific innovation/project implemented
 - d) description of innovation/project outcomes
3. Nomination Form and completed abstract must be received by deadline of **9/20/10**.

EXAMPLES OF POSSIBLE NOMINATIONS

1. A practicing nurse who has implemented an evidence-based clinical innovation.
2. An individual or group who has used research to develop an innovative program that has improved patient care delivery.
3. An individual or group who has promoted hospital-wide programs for use of research in clinical practice.
4. An individual or group who has creatively encouraged others to apply study findings to the practice setting.
